Shorewood Men's Club to Host Candidate Forum

Next Wednesday, March 16 the Shorewood Men's Club will be hosting a Candidate Forum for Village Trustee and Shorewood School Board at Hubbard Park Lodge.

The forum is open to all Village residents (as is the social hour and dinner that precedes the forum). Details regarding the event are below. There is no charge to attend the forum, although if you are attending the preceding dinner, there is a cost. It is not necessary to attend the social hour or the dinner to watch the forum.

- Trustee Candidate Forum: 7:00 pm
- School Board Candidate Forum: 7:40 pm
